SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

OPENING PRAYER

ICE BREAKER: Create your own icebreaker question to get the group interacting.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read Matthew 9:35-10:15

- 1. What is the BIG IDEA of the Scripture as it was taught this week?
- 2. What in this text caught your attention?
- 3. What does this text tell us about God?
- 4. What does this text tell us about ourselves/mankind?
- 5. What is the Christ Connection?
- 6. What should our response be to this text?

APPLICATION

- 1. What is your nagging unanswered question?
- 2. What did you want to hear that you didn't hear from the message?
- 3. How can we get to know God as He is and not in the limited way we do now?
- 4. Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do?
- 5. What's one thing from this text that you could say to an unbeliever about who God is?

PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

SHEPHERDING

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be meet by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you."

MONTHLY MEMORY VERSE FOR JANUARY:

Ephesians 2:8–9: For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

REMINDERS
