At our most recent covenant member meeting, I was able to share some good news, and I simply want to take this opportunity to share that same news with those of you who were not able to join us.

Let me give you two challenges. First, if you have not met one of these brothers or sisters, look them up on the directory so you can put a face to the name. Then, reach out to them, introduce yourself, and get to know them or invite them out to lunch after church. Second, now that the church directory is available for our members, commit to praying for your brothers and sisters here at FCC.

Jesus said, "By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." (John 13:35) May we be a people that are known for our love for one another.







I am also blessed to share that by God's grace and your faithful giving, our church is in a solid financial position. The financial team, led by Ron Hansen, has recommended that the church allocate thirty thousand dollars to make a one-time down payment towards our mortgage. The elders approved that recommendation. If you have been here for some time you may know that the church was scheduled to pay off its mortgage by the end of 2027. Through your generosity in giving to the Lord through the church, we are now scheduled to pay off the church's mortgage in December of 2026.

Finally, the mission statement of FCC is "We make disciples who plant the church." This follows the biblical mission given to the church by the Lord Jesus to make disciples (Matthew 28:18-20). The culmination of making disciples in an area is the planting of a local church. Faith Community Church has a rich heritage of doing just that. With the Lord's help, it is my sincere desire that we would return to that mission. One small step that the Elders have taken towards the work of church planting is to find like minded church planters, and seek to come alongside and bless what God is already doing. So, the Elders have determined to take the fifteen thousand dollars that was set aside in the past for church planting and financially support three church plants. FCC is providing five thousand dollars in funding to three churches. The first is a Hispanic church plant on the North side of New Richmond named Iglesia El Camino (Church of the Way). It is led by Pastor Alberto. The second is a new church plant in Stillwater Minnesota: Christ the King Church. It is led by pastor and author Andi Naselli. The final church plant is Exalting Christ Church in Minneapolis, Minnesota, led by Pastor Brian Davis. It is my prayer that this is only the beginning of our renewal of church planting here at FCC.



A CHALLENGE TO PRAY

for the 30 Days of Ramadan

We have an opportunity to join with Christians around the world who will be praying for the 1.8 billion Muslims around the world to encounter the one true God during their holy month of Ramadan. Ramadan is a special month on the Muslim calendar that is expected to begin at sundown on February 28 and end on March 30. During this time, Muslims fast from sunup to sundown to seek their god, Allah, through more fervent prayer. They believe that abstaining from earthly pleasures will help to cleanse their soul from sin, and that during this holy month they may be blessed with a chance to actually encounter their god.

We know that God loves Muslims, and Jesus came to earth to give His life for them just as He did for us. But because we are God's children, we don't have to wait for a special night during a special month on the calendar to hope to connect with our God – because of Christ, we have access to him 24/7/365.

Would you consider using the privilege we have to enter the throne room to intercede for those who do not yet have that access? During the month of Ramadan, when Muslims are fervently praying and seeking, many have come to faith in Jesus through dreams, visions, "chance" encounters with Christians or with Scripture, and many other ways.

But, what if I don't know how to pray for Muslims? There are many resources that are available to help guide your prayers against specific objections and spiritual strongholds that keep Muslims from coming to faith. One excellent resource is produced by Prayercast. By signing up at this link, you can receive a daily email with specific prayer points as well as a video with a Muslim Background Believer leading you in a short prayer.

Faith Community, committed to making disciples, will be providing Pastor Edwin with the funds to purchase 60 Bibles in both the English and Acholi languages. These Bibles will allow Pastor Edwin to provide continuing knowledge of those so hungry for God's Word and a physical Bible of their own.

RUBY'S PANTRY

Future Plans

It was the summer of 2020 when the ladies of First Lutheran approached me and asked for our church to step in and take over Ruby's Pantry. They were struggling during this time to keep up with the demand of the current needs found in New Richmond. There was also this little thing of the COVID19 pandemic happening. Ruby's Pantry was serving 500-600 people per month and we (FCC) decided to invest. It was literally one of the only outreach programs going on during this time. We learned the system, we preached the Gospel, we grew the ministry!!

Through time, we went from handing our shares in the High School parking lot due to Covid restrictions, to handing out shares in the Freedom Park parking lot, and then God opened a door back up at the local Armory. We currently are still hosting our distributions in the Armory, and it has been a huge blessing to keep up with the drive thru and serve our community anywhere from 150-300 shares each and every month. We have a prayer team that offers prayer to everyone that comes through the line at Ruby's and we have seen first-hand how God has opened doors and connected us to people we wouldn't have had access to prior to taking over this ministry.

With a Gospel focus, our Ruby's lead team has been constantly looking for creative ways of getting the Truth into people's hands. We hand out Gospel tracts. We give out church service invites. We created "gospel goodie bags". We pray with our people. We minister to our workers.

With all that said... we are thanking God for the opportunity of partnering with Ruby's to make a difference here in New Richmond. But now, we are looking towards the future. We have been noticing a decline in people using the resource of Ruby's. It appears that we (FCC) are being pulled in another direction, and our lead team made the decision to look at what God is doing in and our church. We want unashamedly proclaim the Good News in fresh ways and encourage those around us to do the same! So, we have made the decision to close the chapter of partnering with Ruby's Pantry and will be considering some new local partnerships, and bringing back ways we can serve the community again.

Ruby's Pantry has been another blessing to our community and to our church. We have worked very diligently over the last 5 years to reflect Christ to our community and for that I say WELL DONE.




LADIES MONTHLY **BOOK GLUB**


Saturday, March 15th


