## OPENING PRAYER

Talk about a time in your life where it was extremely difficult to forgive **ICE BREAKER:** someone, but you did it!

# **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

#### Read Matthew 6:14-15

- 1. In the sermon, Pastor Patrick said that forgiveness does not come naturally to sinful men. Do you agree with this statement? Why or
- why not? How have you seen the world speak on forgiveness?
  Have you seen someone refuse to forgive others? What happened?
  Thomas Watson defines forgiveness as, "When we strive against all thoughts of revenge; when we will not do our enemies mischief, but wish well to them, grieve at their calamities, pray for them, seek reconciliation with them, and show ourselves ready on all occasions to relieve them" What do you think of that definition? Is there anything you would add? Is there anything you would take away?
- 4. Pastór Patrick also walked through seven things forgiveness is not. Have you ever seen forgiveness misunderstood and misapplied? What happened?
- 5. How might you seek to counsel a Christian that just can't seem to get past someone's sin against them?
- 6. Is the hurt from past sins definitive evidence that someone has not forgiven someone else?
  7. In the story from Corrie Ten Boom she stated, "Forgiveness is an act of the will, and the will can function regardless of the temperature of the heart." What do you think of that statement?
  8. In the sermon, Pastor Patrick said that forgiveness flows from the gospel? Read and interact with Colossians 3:13 and Ephesians 4:32.

## APPLICATION

Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do? What's one thing from this text that you could say to an unbeliever about who God is?

## PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

### SHEPHERDING

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be meet by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you.
