TITLE: "And When You Pray..."

SCRIPTURE: Matthew 6:5-8

SPEAKER: Patrick Mostek

OPENING PRAYER

ICE BREAKER: Talk about a time someone prayed for/with you and how it impacted you.

THINK BACK: Referring back to this week's sermon... What is the BIG IDEA of the Scripture AS IT WAS TAUGHT THIS WEEK? Was there anything that left you with questions?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read Matthew 6:5-8

- 1. Why do you think Christians struggle to pray? What have you struggled to pray in your life?
- 2. How did the culture of Jesus day see prayer?
- 3. How does our world see prayer today?
- 4. How does Jesus' instructions on prayer radical for both then and now?
- 5. Does praying always guarantee what you get what you want?
- 6. Does God hear all prayers the same way? (This question is meant to help you get to the gospel.)

7. PLEASE SPEND THE REMAINING TIME IN PRAYER AS A SMALL GROUP

APPLICATION

Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do? What's one thing from this text that you could say to an unbeliever about who God is?

PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

SHEPHERDING

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be meet by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you."

MONTHLY MEMORY VERSE:

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. John 14:6

REMINDERS

Small Group Checklist

- Ask about ideas to serve in some way together. Serve 1x every six weeks or so.
- Encourage people to invite friends or neighbors to your group!! One way to reach 'out' together is to welcome people 'in.'
- Discuss childcare, if needed.
- Talk about any upcoming group meals or activities.
