SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

OPENING PRAYER

ICE BREAKER: What do most people treasure?

THINK BACK: Referring back to this week's sermon... What is the BIG IDEA of the Scripture AS IT

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read Matthew 6:19-24

- 1. What are you tempted to treasure in this world?
- 2. How can we guard our hearts from that temptation?
- 3. Why does Jesus prohibit us from storing up treasures on earth?
- 4. Have you seen examples of how someone lost something that they treasured? What happened?
- 5. How can someone know if they are storing up treasures in Heaven? What are some examples of how to store up treasures in Heaven?
- 6. Why do you think Jesus leaves it open and does not give "10 steps how to store up treasures in Heaven?
- 7. What does it mean to fix our eyes on Jesus?
- 8. How would you counsel a Christian friend that has clearly "lost sight" of Jesus?
- 9. How do you know who you follow?

APPLICATION

Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do? What's one thing from this text that you could say to an unbeliever about who God is?

PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

SHEPHERDING

WAS TAUGHT THIS WEEK? Was there anything that left you with questions?

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be meet by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you."
