#### OPENING PRAYER

# **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

#### Read Matthew 5:38-42

- 1. Have you ever thought about if Christians can engage in violence? What do you think? Support your view from Scripture.
- 2. In the sermon Pastor Patrick said that conflict often reveals our Christian maturity. Do you agree or disagree? How can viewing conflict as a test help us honor God?
- 3. Have you ever heard the phrase 'an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth' before? What did you think it meant? What did it actually mean?
- 4. Why do you think the Pharisees misinterpreted the passage? How can we avoid falling into the trap of the Pharisees in misinterpreting the Bible?
- 5. How do you typically view the government? What does Romans 13 say about the government?
- 6. Have you ever heard some excuse wrong behavior by saying, 'thats just who I am'? What does the Bible have to say about that attitude.
- 7. Are Christians prohibited from using their rights? Why or why not?
- 8. Why should Christians be known for their generosity?

## APPLICATION

Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do? What's one thing from this text that you could say to an unbeliever about who God is?

#### PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

#### SHEPHERDING

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be meet by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you."
