# SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION GUIDE

### **OPENING PRAYER**

ICE BREAKER:

Who in your group is traveling the furthest for the holidays this year? Who are you

going to see?

THINK BACK: Referring back to this week's sermon... What is the BIG IDEA of the Scripture AS IT

WAS TAUGHT THIS WEEK? Was there anything that left you with questions?

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

#### Read Matthew 1:18-25

- 1. In the sermon, Patrick said that everyone has to make a decision about Jesus. And no decision is a decision. Do you agree with this statement? What Scripture would you use to make your point?
- 2. Why do so many people struggle with Jesus being God? What alternatives do they offer about Jesus? What Bible verses would you point to show Jesus is God?
- 3. Why is it important that Christian's believe in and teach the deity of Jesus?
- 4. Why is Jesus' name significant?
- 5. How does the deity of Christ compel Christian obedience? Can you give an example of how considering Christ has changed the way you acted?
- 6. What did Jesus cost Joseph? Should Jesus cost us something? What has Jesus cost you?
- 7. What did Joseph gain through his faith?

#### **APPLICATION**

Think about what most caught your attention in the text or discussion. Why is God catching your attention with this at this point in your life? What does God want you to know or do? What's one thing from this text that you could say to an unbeliever about who God is?

#### PRAYER

Ask people for specific prayer requests. Pray for needs and for applications of the text. Ask for volunteers who would like to pray for those people and requests.

#### SHEPHERDING

Check the roster and see who is not there. Does the group know why someone is not there? Are there needs that can be meet by the group? Specific prayer requests? Ask for someone to reach out and say, "We missed you."
