## EASTER CHALLENGE

It may not feel like it, but Easter is just around the corner. The resurrection of the Lord Jesus is the greatest event in all of history and we want all of New Richmond and St. Croix County to know about it! And, I want to ask for your help. Would you invite at least one friend to join you for worship this Easter Sunday?

Let me explain why inviting someone is important:

- "About two-thirds of people are willing to receive information about a local church from a family member, and 56 percent from a friend or neighbor." (LifeWay Research)
- "Perhaps one of the most underestimated reasons people return to the church is that someone simply invited them back. 41% of the formerly churched said they would return to the local church if a friend or acquaintance invited them" (Outreach Magazine, Jan 2007. Thom Rainer and Sam Rainer)
- It is one of the most likely times in the year in which non-Christians are willing to visit a church. (LifeWay research)

So, let me offer a challenge. Take the time to reach out and personally invite someone you know to join you for worship at FCC on Easter. After you have talked to them, give them one of the invitation cards from our church with all the information they need. And when they arrive, ask them to sit next to you. Walk them over to the Connection Point in the foyer and make sure they get their free gift. Introduce them to some of your friends (don't forget to say "hi" to me too!). This Easter, let's be a church that invites others to join us in celebrating the hope of the resurrection.

### OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

As shoeboxes have been distributed to 100+countries this past year, thousands of individuals have been reached for the Gospel. The shoebox gifts that you have packed and sent are only the beginning of the story. As these gifts are distributed around the world, many are hearing the Gospel for the very first time. In fact, 365 Unreached People Groups heard the Gospel through shoebox gift distributions in 2024. Operation Christmas Child's shoebox ministry is a powerful disciple making ministry.

Through the Operation Christmas Child Ministry, every 24 hours:

## Book Recommendation

## EVANGELISM AND THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD


by JI Packer

If God is divinely controlling all circumstances in His creation – including salvation – why do we find an emphasis on evangelism in the Scriptures? What is the relationship between God's sovereignty and man's responsibility? If you have ever grappled with these questions, as I have, this book would be of value to you. In "Evangelism and the Sovereignty of God", Packer takes on an often controversial doctrine and lays it out for his readers calmly and precisely.

Written 60 years ago, this topic is just as relevant and debated today. Packer's goal in this tiny, four-chaptered book is to make it evident that "...far from inhibiting evangelism, faith in the sovereignty of God's government and grace is the only thing that can sustain it [evangelism], for it is the only thing that can give us the resilience that we need if we are to evangelize boldly and persistently, and not be daunted by temporary setbacks".

There is much about this book that I benefited from but two things especially stood out. One is Packer's straightforward summary of the gospel, specifically the need for it to contain God, Sin, Christ and the Summons to Repentance and Faith. He explains each section clearly using Scripture. The other is the way in which he showed that God's Sovereignty should strengthen our evangelism – making us bold, patient and prayerful. I walked away from the last chapter extremely encouraged.

"Evangelism and the Sovereignty of God" is a simple read and yet it stretches our minds to think on something beyond us, something greater than ourselves - God Himself. As Packer says, "It is God who brings men and women under the sound of the gospel and it is God who brings them to faith in Christ. Our evangelistic work is the instrument that He uses for this purpose, but the power that saves is not in the instrument: it is in the hand of the One who uses the instrument".

Hello men of Faith, men at Faith,





## Children's Ministry

### FAMILY DISCIPLESHI

We had a fantastic March in KidZone with lots going on! We had Child Dedications where two of our families, the Utechts and the Skidmores, committed to raising their children in a Christian home in which they model for them what it looks like to follow our Lord and Savior, Jesus, as well as teach them the scriptures; with the support and encouragement of their church (you!).



Because we have made this commitment to our Faith Families, our mission in Children's Ministry is to **HELP** make (little) disciples who plant the church. Although we believe parents have the primary responsibility in the discipleship training of their children, we want to reinforce, support, encourage and equip parents for that high calling.

One way we do that is to provide our current 2nd graders, and older children that have not yet received one, a personalized student study Bible. We were delighted to present these on March 9th this year.



In both Children's Church and Sunday school, we strive to teach the children that God's Word is the Bible and at Faith Community Church, we are a Bible people. We emphasize that we love the Bible because we know that it contains the very words of God and it is His chosen method of communicating with us. It's through the Bible that we come to understand that we are sinners in need of God's grace. It's through the Bible that we come to faith in Jesus, who took the punishment for our sin on the cross; and it's through the Bible that we are made more like Jesus by learning to obey Him.

Because the Bible is so important, we want to help our parents to teach all of our children at FCC to "store up its words in their hearts". We shared the following Psalm with the children during the presentation:

#### Psalm 119:11-16

- 11 I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.
- 12 Blessed are you, O Lord; teach me your statutes!
- 13 With my lips I declare all the rules of your mouth.
- 14 In the way of your testimonies I delight as much as in all riches.
- 15 I will meditate on your precepts and fix my eyes on your ways.
- 16 I will delight in your statutes; I will not forget your word.

It is our hope and prayer that our children will use these new Bibles as the Psalmist desired to; to learn to read their Bible, understand their Bible, meditate on their Bible, and even memorize their Bible.

## Children's Ministry

We further reinforce daily time in their Bibles by encouraging the memorization of our church-wide Monthly Memory Verse. One fun way we do that is through songs in Children's Church. Another is through a puzzle that Katy Everett makes that they put together as a group during Sunday school. There are loads of interactive ways to memorize!










#### To the Ends of the Earth: God, Missions, and You




